

The aim is to support the whole community dealing with dementia. Thus, the Platform will offer such services as:

- 🧩 patient to care giver services
and care giver to patient;
- 🧩 personal Health Record;
- 🧩 caregiver to caregiver services.



Many-Me Platform will support people with mild cognitive impairment, mild to moderate dementia, and people with subjective cognitive impairment who wish to act preventively.

Using the Platform will improve the wellbeing and enable to enjoy an autonomous life for longer, thanks to the system supporting daily activities in a friendly and easy way.

On the other hand, the Platform will bring more comfort for caregivers who are often overburdened with their duties and suffer from different types of problems, including depression.
